Parents and Players Konos Sports Affirmation/ Agreement

Players:

- 1. Student athletes must maintain a minimum of 75 (2.5) GPA in KJ/KA/supplemental courses.
- 2. Athletes who are **not Konos students** should submit a copy of their most recently completed semester grades with grade level stated to be eligible to play.
- 3. Forms required before participation: physical signed by physician (good for 2 years), birth certificate, copy of insurance card, signed athletic agreement and concussion form turn these in to your coach.
- 3. You may not play your sport for another school or home school co-op during the season when you play for Konos. You may play for other teams in the off season.
- 4. Athletes are expected to attend all practices and be on time to all practices and games. It is a player's responsibility to notify his or her coach of any emergencies that would keep him/her from practice or a game. Students must discuss any expected scheduling conflicts with the coach at try-outs. All players must be available to practice at least twice a week.
- 5. Coaches will give Physical Education grades at the end of the season. PE grades are based on participation. These grades are recorded as .5 credit at the end of the school year.
- 6. Coaches may discipline (example: not participate in a game) athletes who break rules or miss practices without permission.
- 7. Coaches will set expectations for appearance and athletes will strive to maintain a neat and orderly appearance. Jewelry and watches should be removed before play to prevent injuries.
- 8. During games, athletes must be in uniform at all times.
- 9. Players must conduct themselves respectfully during all practices and games. Athletes may never use foul language or argue with referees, coaches, or other players. . If a student has a concern about a coach's behavior, that student will communicate that concern to the Athletics Director. Athletes must maintain control of their tempers.
- 10. Konos teams are intended to be competitive and participatory. While coaches are encouraged to play all players, they should not expect to receive equal playing time. Playing time will be determined by the coach in the best interest of the team.

Parents:

- 1. Parents will not argue with or disrupt coaches, referees, players, or other parents during games or practices.
- 2. Parents will support the entire team, not just their own athletes.
- 3. Parents will not confuse cheering with coaching. Parental coaching from the sidelines can confuse players.
- 4. Konos has hired qualified coaches who we believe will behave professionally at all times. Parents will speak directly and respectfully to coaches when they have concerns, rather than making complaints to other parents. If their concerns are not addressed to their satisfaction, parents will contact the Athletics Director with their concerns.
- 5. Parents are responsible for transporting students to games and practices or arranging carpools. If parents ask a coach to transport a student, that request indicates that the parents are holding that coach harmless for any accidents that might occur during transportation.
- 6. Paying on time is essential to insure the smooth running of the sport. There will be an initial \$30 registration for Konos office administrative costs plus 20% of the total fee by the first game or match; then 50% of the total fee will be paid by mid season. If this is not done, the player is "benched" or "sidelined". The final amount will be paid by the last event of the season.
- 7. Fundraising events will be available both before and during the season. Parents are encouraged to help the coach and Athletic Director with these events as well as assist students in fund-raising when possible. The final payment date will be extended when a fundraising event occurs after the end of the season.
- 8. Failure to pay by the cutoff date results in an initial \$20 fine to be added each month thereafter. Failure to fully pay results in future nonparticipation and the holding of all future Konos report cards and transcripts.
